### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Consulate Parking Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD	MISCELLEANEOUS:
42	30 N. Garland Court; Repeal Ordinance Passed 3/29/2006, journal page 73679, which reads: N. Garland Court (east side) from a point 30 feet south of E. Washington Street to a point 25 feet south thereof; No Parking Except Consulate Vehicles Only, 7:00am to 8:00pm, by striking the above (14-00113481) [O2013-6469]
42	E. Delaware Place; Amend Ordinance Passed 9/12/12, journal page 33099, which reads: E. Delaware Place (north side) from a point 295 feet west of N. Mies Van Der Rohe Way to a point 25 feet west thereof; Denmark Consulate Parking Only, 7:00am to 9:00pm, Monday through Friday, by striking 7:00am to 9:00pm and Monday through Friday, and inserting In lieu thereof: E. Delaware Place (north side) from a point 295 feet west of N. Mies Van Der Rohe Way to a point 25 feet west thereof; Denmark Consulate Parking Only, All Times, All Days (14-00543405) [O2014-909]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
