# <u>ORDINANCE</u>

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance,

is hereby amended by changing all the B2-5 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District and RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-F

West Locust Street; a line 233.84 feet east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 109.30 feet south of and parallel to West Locust Street; a line 129.31 feet east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 100.26 feet south of and parallel to West Locust Street; and North Sedgwick Street,

to those of a B2-5 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.



### General background regarding civil status:

The Archdiocese of Chicago is organized as a corporation sole by special act of the Illinois legislature approved in 1845 and amended in 1861. The civil law title for the Archdiocese of Chicago is "The Catholic Bishop of Chicago, an Illinois Corporation Sole". A copy of this statute is available upon request.

The Archbishop of Chicago is de jure the Catholic Bishop of Chicago, a corporation sole, and as such is authorized to act in the interest of all parishes, institutions and agencies under the jurisdiction of the Archdiocese. The Office of the Archbishop is responsible for administering the Archdiocese under both civil and canon law. The corporation sole does not have a board of directors or other structures comparable to the secular entity. The Archbishop, as the Catholic Bishop of Chicago, functions through his own actions rather than as a result of board resolutions or similar processes.

As a corporation sole, we obtain and renew each year a Certificate of Good Standing, a copy of which is available upon request.

NOTE: The Catholic Bishop of Chicago, an Illinois corporation sole is not the same as a "not-for-profit corporation". Without our permission, someone formed and listed the Archdiocese as a not for profit corporation with the Illinois Secretary of State. Pursuant to that filing, the Archdiocese of Chicago was involuntarily listed and then dissolved. That filing (61772359) can be found on the Illinois Secretary of State website. Also on that website, The Catholic Bishop of Chicago appears accurately as a Special Act Corporation (file number 55013179).

Our tax status and the deductibility, for federal income, gift and estate tax purposes, of contributions to the Archdiocese of Chicago is established by a Group Ruling issued by the Internal Revenue Service of the Department of Treasury. A copy of the Group Ruling letter is available upon request.
