ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION'1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B1-1 District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 16-K in the area bounded by

LOTS 23 TO 42 (EXCEPT THAT PART LYING WITHIN THE WEST 50 FEET OF SECTION AND ALSO EXCEPT THAT PART BEING CONDEMNED IN THE CASE NUMBER 64L11423) IN BLOCK 12, ALL IN MARQUETTE RIDGE, A SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTH ½ OF THE WEST ½ OF THE NORTHWEST ¼ AND THE NORTH OF ½ OF THE WEST ½ OF THE NORTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERDIAN, (EXCEPT THE EAST 133 FEET THEREOF) IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.
