SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install and/or amend Reserved Parking (2% Disabled) Signs at the below listed locations:

25	1625 W. 18th Street; Repeal Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), Public Benefit, by striking the above [O2014-7259]
25	1834 W. 18th Street; Repeal Ordinance which reads: 1834 W. 18th Street; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), Public Benefit, by striking the above [O2014-7283]
25	729-731 W. 19th Place; Repeal Ordinance Passed 11/13/2003, journal page 65358, which reads: 729-731 W. 19th Place (south side) from a point 112 feet east of S. Halsted Street to a point 40 feet east thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), by striking the above [O2015-30]
28	431 N. Laramie Avenue; 431 N. Laramie Avenue (east side) from a point 20 feet south of W. Ferdinand Street to a point 30 feet south thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days, Public Benefit – (14-02189108) [O2014-9812]
