ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached Housing) District, as shown on Map 1-G in the area bounded by:

West Erie Street, a line 150.00 feet east of North Armour Street, the alley south and parallel to West Erie Street and a line 175.07 feet east of North Armour Street.

To those of RM-4.5 Residential Multi-Unit District

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.

In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, please be informed that on or about March 11, 2015, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District to RM-4.5 Residential Multi-Unit District for the property located at 1465 West Erie Street, Chicago, Illinois.

The Applicant intends to use the subject property to construct a three story building with roof access, consisting of three (3) residential dwelling units. There will also be three (3) garage parking spaces. The footprint of the building shall be approximately 20 feet by 78 feet 7½ inches in size and the building shall be 37 feet 10 inches high, as defined by City Code.


