ORDINANCE SOUTH WELLS PLACE Acct. No. 396789 - 2 Permit No. 1119103

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SOUTH WELLS PLACE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use seven (7) Planter(s) on the public right-of-way for beautification purposes adjacent to its premises known as 837 S. Wells St..

Said Planter(s) at S WELLS ST measure(s):

Two (2) at twenty-nine point eight three (29.83) feet in length, and one point eight three (1.83) foot in width for a total of one hundred nine point one eight (109.18) square feet.

One (1) at ten point five (10.5) feet in length, and one point eight three (1.83) foot in width for a total of nineteen point two two (19.22) square feet.

One (1) at eight point one seven (8.17) feet in length, and one point eight three (1.83) foot in width for a total of fourteen point nine five (14.95) square feet.

Said Planter(s) at S FINANCIAL PL measure(s):

Two (2) at twenty-nine point eight three (29.83) feet in length, and one point eight three (1.83) foot in width for a total of one hundred nine point one eight (109.18) square feet.

One (1) at thirteen point five eight (13.58) feet in length, and one point eight three (1.83) foot in width for a total of twenty-four point eight five (24.85) square feet.

Grantee must allow the required clear and unobstructed space for pedestrian passage at all times per rules and regulations approved by the Department of Transportation.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1119103 herein granted the sum of zero (\$.00) per annum in advance.


A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
