ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Chicago City Council may from time to time define areas, in the interest of preserving public health and safety or avoiding traffic congestion, in which no mobile food dispenser vendor may prepare or dispense food from a wheeled vehicle or cart; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-8-037 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby by amended by inserting the language underscored and by adding a new Section 4-8-037 (2), as follows:

4-8-037 Restrictions on mobile food vendors

The city council may from time to time define areas, in the interest of preserving public health and safety or avoiding traffic congestion, in which no mobile food dispenser vendor may prepare or dispense food from a wheeled vehicle. The city clerk shall maintain for public inspection and copying a file of all ordinances defining such areas. Dispensing or preparing food from a wheeled vehicle within the following designated areas is hereby prohibited:

(1) Beginning at the intersection of Laflin Street and Monroe Street; thence south on Laflin Street to Jackson Boulevard, thence west on Jackson Boulevard to Paulina Street, thence north on Paulina Street to Monroe Street; thence east on Monroe Street to Laflin Street.


