ORDINANCE Chicago Public School Acct. No. 302602 - 20 Permit No. 1120105

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Chicago Public School, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, four (4) Fence(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 6350 S. Stewart Ave..

Said Fence(s) at S. Stewart Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at two hundred ninety (290) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of two hundred ninety (290) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

Said Fence(s) at W. 64th Street measure(s):

One (1) at two hundred thirty-two (232) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of two hundred thirty-two-(232) square feet. Existing fence is approximately four (4) feet in height.

Said Fence(s) at W. 64th Street measure(s):

One (1) at thirty-four (34) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of thirty-four (34) square feet. Existing fence is approximately six (6) feet in height.

Said Fence(s) at S. Eggleston Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at twelve (12) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of twelve (12) square feet. Existing fence is approximately six (6) feet in height.

Said Fence(s) at S. Eggleston Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred (100) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of one hundred (100) square feet. Existing fence is approximately six (6) feet in height.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1120105 herein granted the sum of zero (\$.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 06/30/2015.
