#### SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE



WHEREAS, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the year 2015 of the City of Chicago (the "City") contains estimates of revenues receivable as grants from agencies of the state and federal governments and public and private agencies; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 8 of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance, the heads of various departments and agencies of the City have applied to agencies of the state and federal governments and public and private agencies for grants to the City for various purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Cultural Affairs and Special Events ("DCASE") has been awarded private grant funds in the amount of \$125,000 from Allstate Insurance Company which shall be used for the Fifth Star Awards Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through DCASE has been awarded private grant funds in the amount of \$25,000 from Grosvenor Holdings, LLC which shall be used for the Fifth Star Awards Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Public Health ("Health") has been awarded additional federal grant funds in the amount of \$236,000 from the United States Department of Health & Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration which shall be used for the Ryan White CARE Act Program;

WHEREAS, the City through Health has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$3,024,00 by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") which shall be used for the Reduce HIV and Improve Care for MSM and Transgender People Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through Health has been awarded additional federal grant funds in the amount of \$122,000 by the CDC which shall be used for the HIV/AIDs Prevention Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Family and Support Services has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$48,000 by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs which shall be used for the 2015 Enumeration of Homeless Veterans Point in Time Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Transportation has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$1,301,000 by the Federal Transit Administration which shall be used for the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Water Management has been awarded state grant funds in the amount of \$11,000,000 by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources which shall be used for the Albany Park Flood Control Project;

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Innovation and Technology ("Dolt") received in fiscal year 2013 private grant funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the Bloomberg Family Foundation Inc. to be used for the Bloomberg Foundation Challenge Grant Smart Data Platform Program and the Chief Information Officer of the City was then authorized to enter into an agreement, upon such terms and conditions that he or she determines are appropriate with Carnegie Mellon

University ("CMU") for the provision of certain services for \$600,000 which shall be paid directly by the Bloomberg Family Foundation Inc. with respect to the Smart Data Platform Program, and now Dolt desires to replace CMU with the University of Chicago ("U of C"); now, therefore,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

- SECTION 1. The sum of \$15,881,000 not previously appropriated, representing increased grant awards, is hereby appropriated from Fund 925 Grant Funds for the year 2015. The Annual Appropriation Ordinance is hereby further amended by striking the words and figures and adding the words and figures indicated in the attached Exhibit A which is hereby made a part hereof.
- SECTION 2. The Chief Information Officer of the City is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, upon such terms and conditions that he or she determines are appropriate with the U of C or an affiliate thereof, for the provision of certain services, by U of C or its affiliate, for the amount of \$600,000 which shall be paid directly by the Bloomberg Family Foundation Inc. to the U of C or its affiliate with respect to the Smart Data Platform Program.
- SECTION 3. To the extent that any ordinance, resolution, rule, order or provision of the Municipal Code of Chicago, or part thereof, is in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall control. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.
  - SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
