## <u>**O** R D I N A N C E</u>

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the RS3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House)

District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.17-G in the area bounded by

a line 33.5 feet north of and parallel to the alley next north of and parallel to West Devon Avenue; the alley next east of and parallel to North Glenwood Avenue; the alley next north of and parallel to West Devon Avenue; and North Glenwood Avenue,

to those of a RT3.5 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.


