#### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 9-I in the area bounded by

West Roscoe Street; A line 469.50 feet west of and parallel to North California Avenue; the east-west public alley south of and parallel to West Roscoe Street; A line 507.00 feet west of and parallel to North California Avenue

to those of a RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.
