ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, For almost 50 years, the City of Chicago provided atfordable health care coverage for its retirees, but in 2013 the City announced it would implement a brac-year phase out of health care subsidies to almost all retirees; and

WHEREAS, Retiree health insurance is a benefit that employees earn while they work which, once earned, should not be unilaterally taken away and, as a need the Digns failure to honor its obligations, this phase-out is currently being challenged in court by a group of retrees and their widows; and

WHEREAS, The median annual pension for retirees in the Municipal Employee Annulty and Benefit Fund (MEABF) is between \$27,000 and \$30,000, and more than 9,000 of those annuitants rely on the City for health insurance; and

WHEREAS, Virtually every City of Chicago retiree has been harmed by the City's cuts to health insurance subsidies, which results in some retirees spending over half their modest pensions on health care; and

WHEREAS, Certain retirees who are over 65 but are not eligible for Medicare because they were hired before March 31, 1986, when Medicare was extended to public employees, are especially and unfairly hard hit: now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-152-171 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language stricken and inserting the language underscored, as follows.

2-152-171 Reserved Continued health insurance subsidy for certain retireet.

The City shall cover 80% of the health care expenses incurred by each Augustan Employee Annuity and Benefit Fund annuitant aged 65 years or older who participates in the Non-Medicare Eligible Retiree Healthcare Plan.

BECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication of the state of the sta
