BYLINE BANK

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BYLINE BANK, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use two (2) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 800 N. State St..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along N. State Street:
One (1) at three (3) feet in length, three (3) feet in height and twenty-two (22) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W. Chicago Avenue:
One (1) at three (3) feet in length, three (3) feet in height and twenty-two (22) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.


This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1121605 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

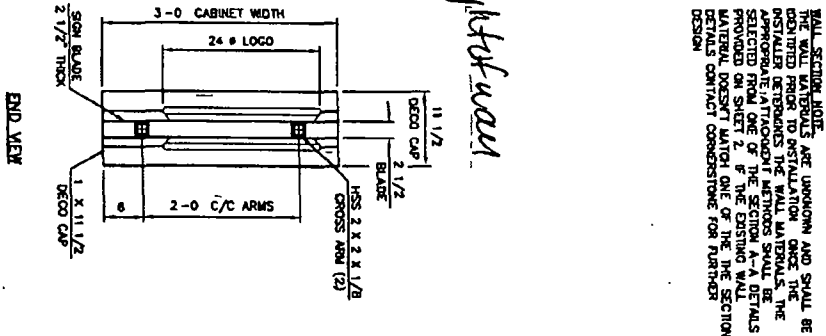
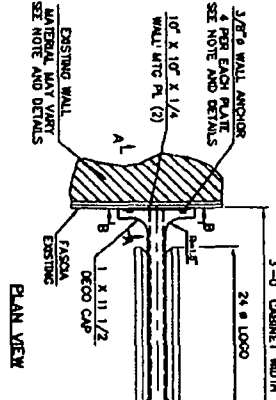
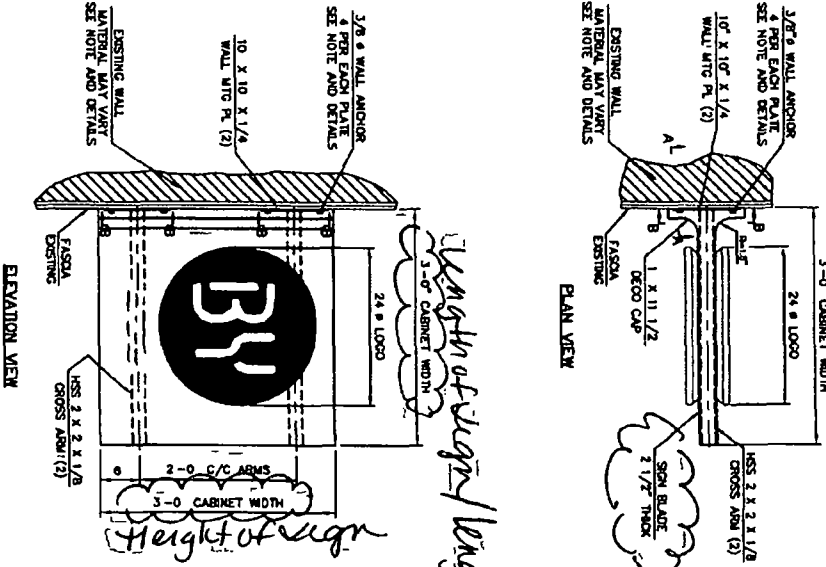

GENERAL NOTES:

1. All design, fabrication, installation and construction shall be in accordance with the applicable codes and standards unless specifically noted otherwise on the drawings.
2. The Chicago Building Code, American Institute of Steel Construction, Inc. Manual of Steel Construction (13th Edition), American Welding Society, Steel Manual, and The Aluminum Association Design Manual 2010 Edition.
3. All components shall be as listed below unless noted otherwise:
 - a. All structural aluminum shall be 6061-T6.
 - b. All structural steel shall be A36.
 - c. All steel rod and anchor bolts shall be A307.
 - d. All steel structural tubing shall be ASTM A500 Grade B or equal.
4. Mechanical seal fasteners shall be installed according to manufacturers specifications. All fasteners to non-ferrous materials shall be adequately deposited to prevent corrosion. All bolts in contact with steel and aluminum shall be galvanized or stainless steel.
5. All field welds shall be A324 bolts or equivalent. All exposed materials shall be properly protected from weathering and/or corrosion.
6. All field welds shall be made by a welder certified in the specified position.
7. The structure has been designed to withstand a design wind pressure of 50 psf as per the CRC.
8. If existing and proposed conditions are not as detailed in this design drawing the installer shall notify the engineer immediately.
9. If the integrity of the structure is in question, the engineer shall verify the structure immediately for re-design.

SEALER NOTE:
WHERE THE WALL FASCIA IS OF 2" OR ANOTHER COMPRESSIBLE MATERIAL, ROOF SPACING SHALL BE USED AROUND THE SEALER AND FROM THE BRACING OR ROOF WALL MATERIAL.

Height to bottom = 20'0"
Height to top = 25'0"

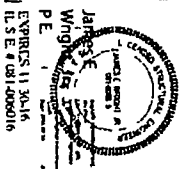


Height of sign length along right of wall

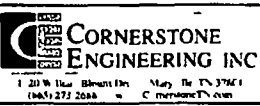
STANDARD DESIGN:
