#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO;

SECTION 1. Section 1 Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago , The Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is HEREBY amended by changing all the RS3 Residential Single Unit (detached house) District symbols and indications as shown on Map  $\sharp$  6-G in an area bounded by:

BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST LINE OF THE 16-FOOT PUBLIC ALLEY; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY A DISTANCE OF 48.00 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY A DISTANCE OF 100.00 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 45.00 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 4.26 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 97.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.






