BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:


SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the **C1-1 Neighborhood Commercial District.**, as shown on Map 11-J in the area bounded by:

A line 225.00 feet east of and parallel to North Kimball Avenue, West Irving Park Road, a line 250.00 feet east of and parallel to North Kimball Avenue, the public alley next south of and parallel to West Irving Park Road.

To those of B2-3 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.
