ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all of the RM-6 Residential Multi-Unit District and Institutional Planned Development No. 788 symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 15-G in the area bounded by:

West Rosemont Avenue; North Sheridan Road; West Granville Avenue; the alley next west of North Sheridan Road; a line 150 feet north of West Granville Avenue; North Kenmore Avenue; a line 250 feet north of West Granville Avenue; and the alley next west of North Sheridan Road

to the designation of Institutional Planned Development No. 788, as amended, subject to such use and bulk regulations as are set forth in the Plan of Development attached hereto and to no others.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

INSTITUTIONAL PLANNED DEVELOPMENT NO. 788, AS AMENDED <u>PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT --- STATEMENTS</u>

1. The area delineated herein as an Institutional Planned Development (the "Planned Development") consists of approximately 104,337 square feet of Property which is depicted on the attached Planned Development Boundary and Property Line Map ("Property") and is owned or controlled by the Applicant, Convent of the Sacred Heart of Chicago, Illinois.

2. The requirements, obligations and conditions contained within this Planned Development shall be binding upon the Applicant, its successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders and any ground lessors. All rights granted hereunder to the Applicant shall inure to the benefit of the Applicant's successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holder and any ground lessors. Furthermore, pursuant to the requirements of Section 17-8-0400 of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance (the "Zoning Ordinance"), the Property, at the time of application for amendments, modifications or changes (administrative, legislative or otherwise) to this Planned Development are made, shall be under single ownership or designated control. Single designated control is defined in Section 17-8-0400 of the Zoning Ordinance.

3. All applicable official reviews, approvals or permits are required to be obtained by the Applicant or its successors, assigns or grantees. Any dedication or vacation of streets or alleys or grants of easements or any adjustment of the right-of-way shall require a separate

submittal to the Department of Transportation on behalf of the Applicant or its successors, assigns or grantees. Any requests for grants of privilege, or any items encroaching on the public way, shall be in compliance with the Plans. Ingress or egress shall be pursuant to the Plans and may be subject to the review and approval of the Departments of Planning and Development and Transportation. Closure of all or any public street or alley during demolition or construction shall be subject to the review and approval of the Department of Transportation. All work proposed in the public way must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Department of Transportation Construction Standards for Work in the Public Way and in compliance with the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago. Prior to the issuance of any Part II approval, the submitted plans must be approved by the Department of Transportation.

4. This Plan of Development consists of 14 Statements; a Bulk Regulations Table; an Existing Zoning Map; an Existing Land Use Map; a Planned Development Boundary and Property Line Map; a Site Plan; a Landscape Plan; and a Plant List prepared by Terry Guen Design Associates dated June 22, 2016. Full-sized copies of the Site Plan and Landscape Plan are on file with the Department of Planning and Development. In any instance where a provision of this Planned Development conflicts with the Chicago Building Code, the Building Code shall control. This Planned Development conforms to the intent and purpose of the Zoning Ordinance, and all requirements thereof, and satisfies the established criteria for approval as a Planned Development. In case of a conflict between the terms of this Planned Development Ordinance

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and the Zoning Ordinance, this Planned Development Ordinance shall control.

5. The following uses are allowed in this Planned Development: educational and/or student-related facilities; accessory uses and accessory parking.

6. On-Premise signs and temporary signs, such as construction and marketing signs, shall be permitted within the Planned Development, subject to the review and approval of the Department of Planning and Development. Off-Premise signs are prohibited within the boundary of the Planned Development.

7. Off-street parking and loading facilities shall be provided in accordance with the provisions of this Planned Development subject to the review and approval of the Departments of Transportation and Planning and Development. Any service drive or other ingress or egress shall be adequately designed and paved, in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Transportation in effect at the time of construction and in compliance with the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, to provide ingress and egress for motor vehicles, including emergency vehicles. There shall be no parking within such emergency areas. Ingress and egress shall be subject to the review and approval of the Departments of Transportation and Planning and Development. Closure of all or part of any public streets or alleys during demolition or construction shall be subject to the review and approval of the Department of Transportation.

8. For purposes of height measurement, the definitions in the Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The height of any building shall also be subject to height limitations, if any, established by the Federal Aviation Administration.

9. The maximum permitted Floor Area Ratio ("FAR") for the site shall be in accordance with the attached Bulk Regulations Table. For the purposes of FAR calculations and measurements, the definitions in the Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The permitted FAR identified in the Bulk Regulations Table has been determined using a Net Site Area of 104,337 square feet.

10. The Site Plan and Landscape Plan shall be in substantial conformance with the Landscape Ordinance and any other corresponding regulations and guidelines. Final landscape plan review and approval will be by the Department of Planning and Development. Any interim reviews associated with partial Part II reviews are conditional until final Part II approval.

11. The terms and conditions of development under this Planned Development ordinance may be modified administratively, pursuant to section 17-13-0611-A of the Zoning Ordinance, by the Zoning Administrator upon the application for such a modification by the Applicant, its successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders and any ground lessors.

12. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct, renovate and maintain all buildings in a manner that provides healthier indoor environments, reduces operating costs, conserves energy and maximizes the preservation of natural resources. The Applicant shall use best and reasonable efforts to design, construct and maintain all Buildings located within this Planned Development in an energy efficient manner, generally consistent with the current City of Chicago Sustainable Development Policy set forth by the Department of Planning and Development.

13. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct and maintain the project in a manner which promotes, enables and maximizes universal access throughout the Property. Plans for any new buildings and improvements on the Property shall be reviewed and approved by the Mayor's Office for People with Disabilities to ensure compliance with all applicable laws and regulations related to access for persons with disabilities and to promote the highest standard of accessibility.

14. This Planned Development shall be governed by Section 17-13-0612 of the Zoning Ordinance. Should this Planned Development ordinance lapse, the Commissioner of the Department of Planning and Development shall initiate a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone the Property to its previous respective designation as either an RM-6 Residential Multi-Unit District or Institutional Planned Development No. 788, as approved by the City Council on June 27, 2001.

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

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
EXISTING ZONING MAP






EXISTING LAND USE MAP





In accordance with the requirements for an amendment to, and a special use application filed pursuant to, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, please be informed that on or about June 15, 2016, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from RM-6 Residential Multi-Unit District and Institutional Planned Development No. 788 (the "Planned Development"), to Institutional Planned Development No. 788, as amended on behalf of the Convent of the Sacred Heart of Chicago, Illinois, whose address is 6250 North Sheridan Road, Chicago, Illinois 60660 (the "Applicant"), for the property located generally at 6250 North Sheridan Road and 6217-21 North Kenmore Avenue, Chicago, Illinois (the "School Property"), and a special use application will be filed with the Zoning Board of Appeals of the City of Chicago for the property at 6169-75 North Kenmore Avenue (the "Parking Lot Property"). Both properties are owned by the Applicant. The School Property contains the Sacred Heart School campus and the Parking Lot Property contains an off-site accessory parking lot that will serve the School Property.


The proposed zoning amendment application seeks to include the property owned by the Applicant at 6221 North Kenmore Avenue within the boundaries of Institutional Planned Development No. 788, which presently includes the balance of the Applicant's campus. This amendment will bring the north half of the existing school parking lot at 6217-21 North Kenmore Avenue within the boundaries of the Planned Development so that the entirety of the School Property will be within the Planned Development's boundaries. An on-site parking lot will also be converted to a turf play field. These improvements will result in the creation of significant additional green space on the School Property. The Parking Lot Property will be used as presently improved as an off-site accessory parking lot for users of the School Property, which requires special use approval due to its off-site location.

This notice is required by Section 17-13-0107 of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago. Please note that the Applicant is not seeking to rezone or purchase your property. The Applicant is required by law to send this notice because you own property within 250 feet of the property to be rezoned and for which special use approval is requested as described above.


