ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all of the RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map 5-G in the area bounded by:

NORTH BISSELL STREET, THE PUBLIC ALLEY NEXT SOUTH OF AND PARALLEL TO WEST WEBSTER AVE, A LINE 74.18 FEET WEST OF NORTH BISSELL, A LINE 48.00 FEET NEXT NORTH OF THE PUBLIC ALLEY,

to those of RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

NARRATIVE ZONING ANALYSIS TYPE 1 ZONING MAP AMENDMENT APPLICATION

Applicant: Park West Cooperative Nursery School

Property Location: 2212-2216 N. Bissell St.

Proposed Zoning: RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District

Lot Area: 3,560.15 sf

Park West Cooperative Nursery School is the "Applicant" for a Type 1 Zoning Map Amendment for the subject property located at 2212-2216 N. Bissell St. (the "Property") from the RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District to the RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District. The Applicant proposes to add a two-story addition to replace an existing private garage and a 3-story addition.

The site is bounded by Bissell Street to the east, a 16 feet public alley to the south, private parking and elevated CTA tracks to the west, and residential properties to the north. The site is located within the Sheffield Historic District. To the north and east of the subject property are properties zoned RT-4, to the south is a property zoned B1-2 and to the west is Planned Development No. 2.

The subject property consists of 3,560.15 square feet and is currently occupied by an existing 3-story residential masonry building. The Applicant proposes to demolish an existing private garage at the rear of the site and replace it with a new two-story addition and a 3-story addition. Both additions will be of masonry construction. The building will be used for a nursery and for offices for nursery staff.

The current side and rear yard setbacks are existing and nonconforming. Both the RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District and the RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District require the same setbacks. Both zones require a front setback of 15 feet or 12 percent of lot depth, whichever is less. Based on a depth of 74.18 feet, the front setback required is 8.9 feet. Both residential districts require a combined total width of side setbacks that equal 20 percent of the lot width with neither required setback less than 2 feet or 8 percent of lot width, whichever is greater and no side setback to exceed 5 feet in width. Based on a total width of 48 feet, the side setback required is 3.84 feet. Both the RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District and the RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District require a rear setback of 30 percent of lot depth or 50 feet, whichever is less. Based on a depth of 74.18 feet, the required rear setback is 22.25 feet.

The Applicant will seek approval of a variation from the Zoning Board of Appeals to reduce the required side setback to .92 feet and to reduce the required rear setback to 0 feet. The proposed project would have a conforming front setback of 14.53 feet. No off-street parking spaces will be provided on-site. The Applicant will provide three parking spaces in an off-site parking lot and will seek a reduction of its parking requirement from the Zoning Board of Appeals.

As required by Section 17-13-0107 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, please be informed that on or about July 15, 2016, the undersigned, on behalf of Park West Cooperative Nursery School (the "Applicant"), intends to file an application to rezone the property located at 2212-2216 N. Bissell St, Chicago, IL from RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District to the RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District. The proposed use of this property will be a daycare and there will be no residential units. A map of the development site is printed on the reverse side of this letter.

The development site is currently occupied by an existing 3-story building. The application requests a rezoning of the subject property from the RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District to the RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District in order to allow for the construction of a new two-story addition to replace an existing private garage and a new construction 3-story addition.

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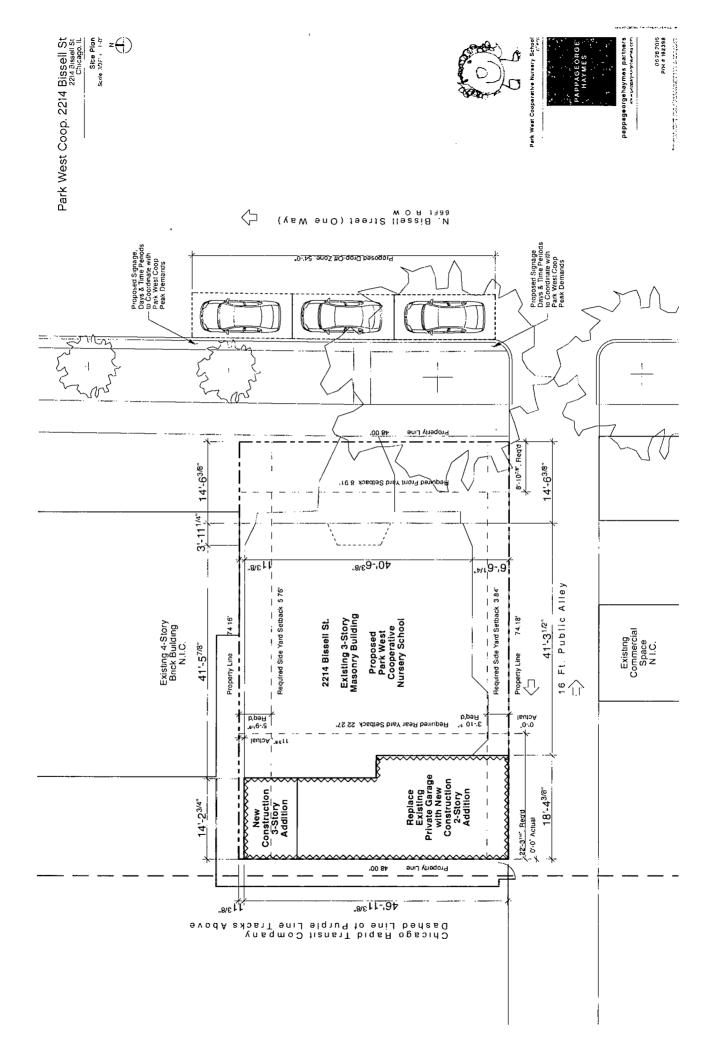
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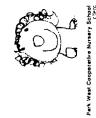
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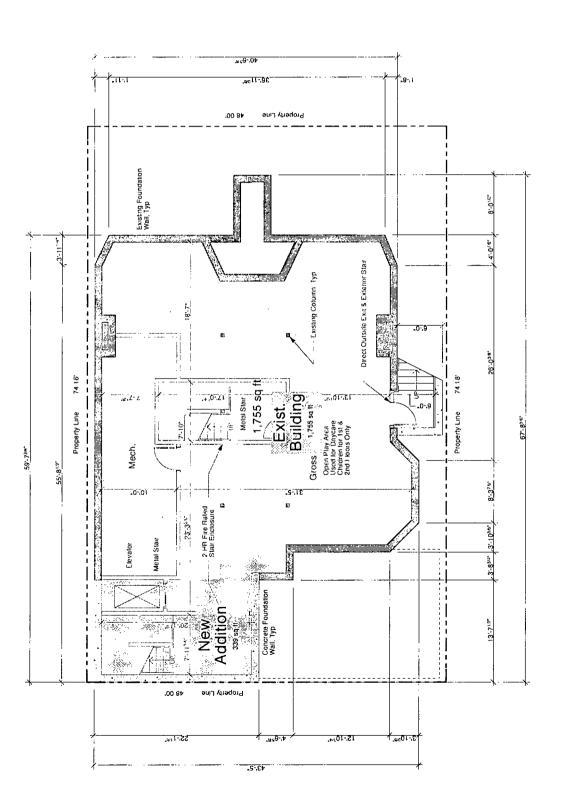
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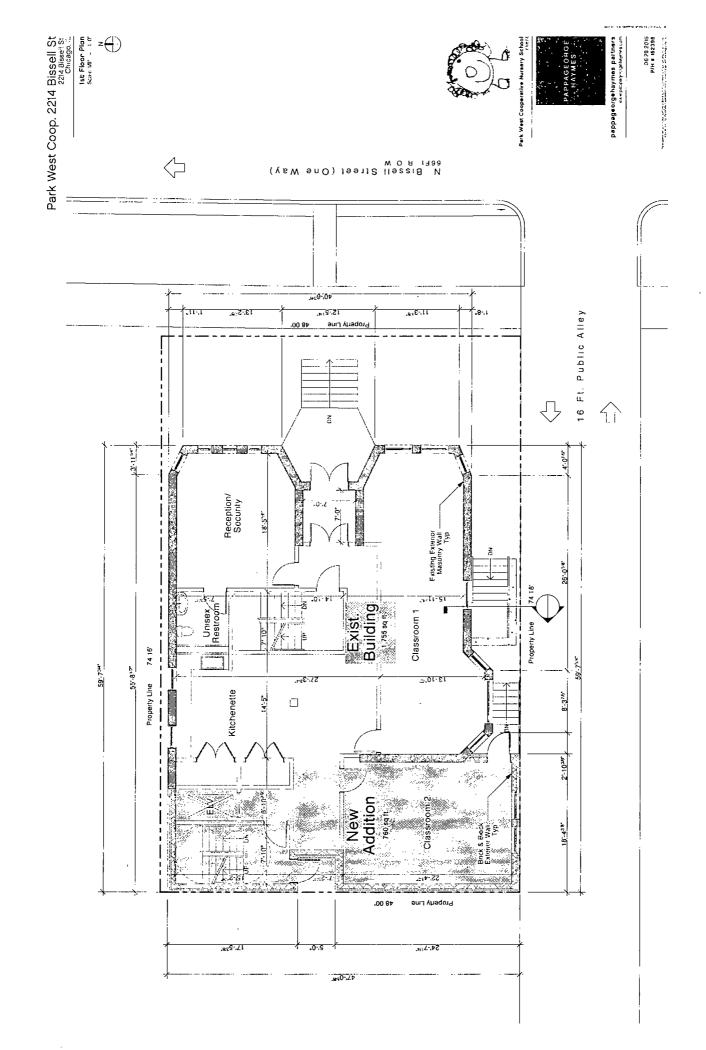
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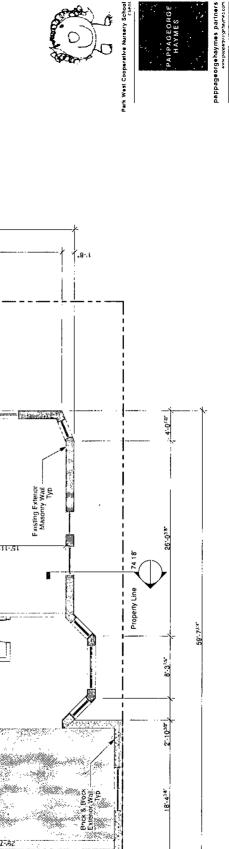
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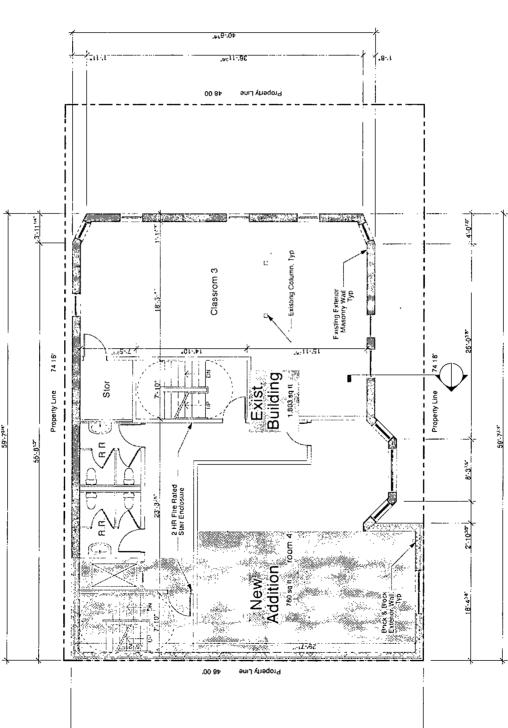
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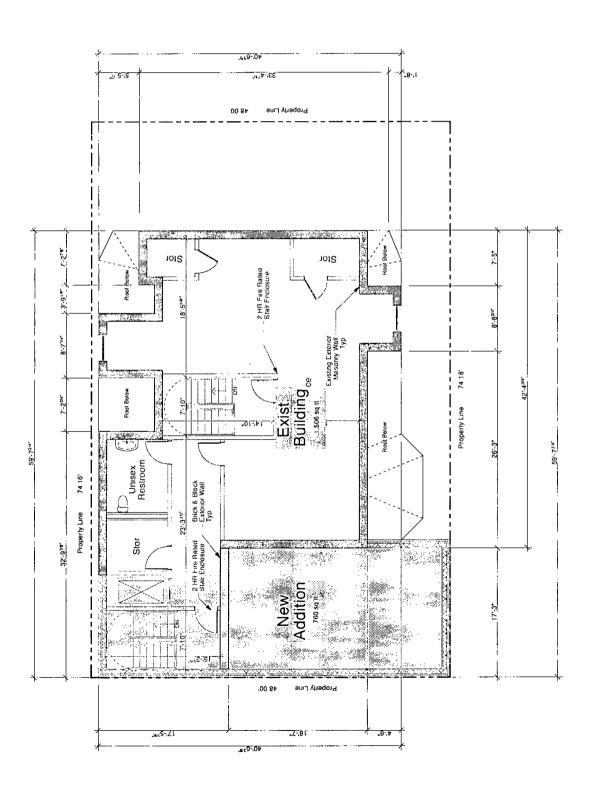


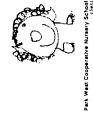




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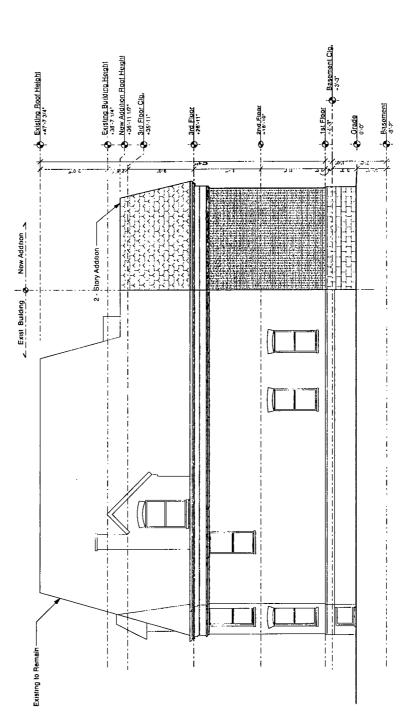




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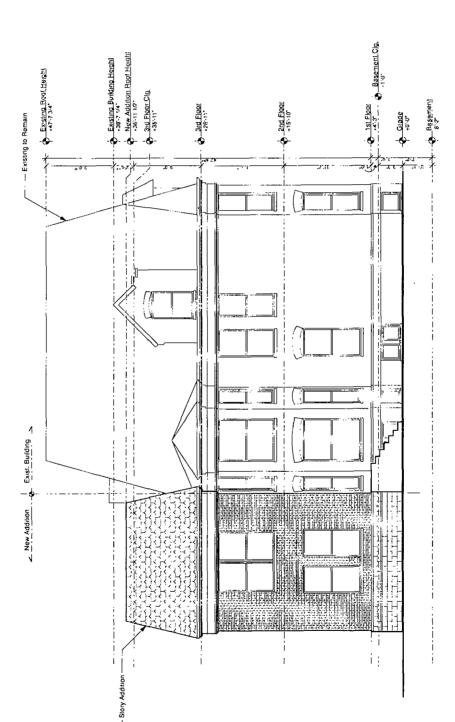


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Service - Existing Root Height 3rd Floor Grade New Addition | Exist, Building

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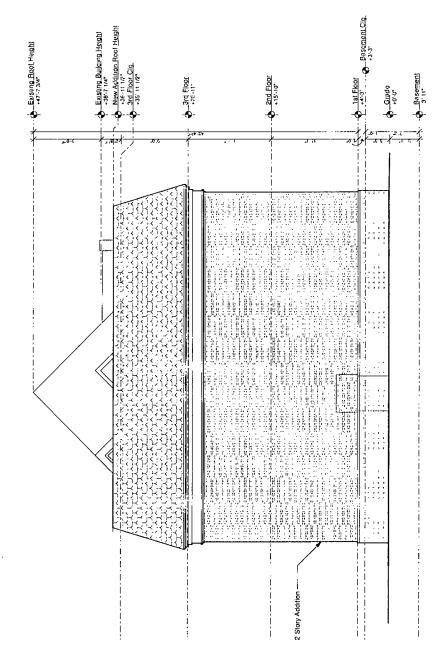

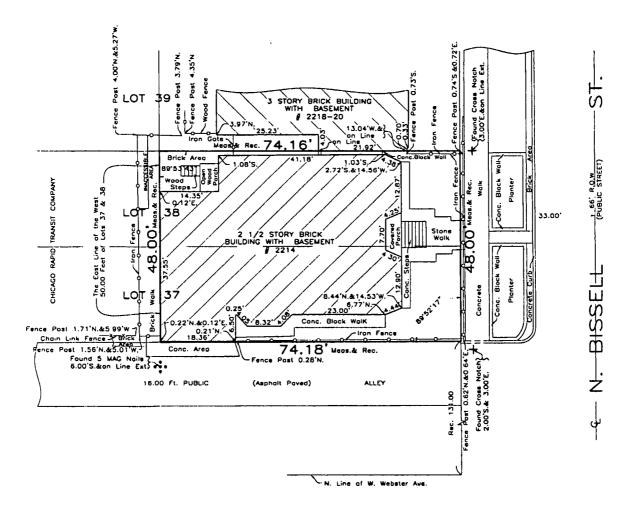
