ORDINANCE TRADER JOE'S #701 Acct. No. 211718 - 6 Permit No. 1123852

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to TRADER JOE'S #701, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, ten (10) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1147 S. Wabash Ave..

Said Awning(s) at E Roosevelt Rd measure(s):

Two (2) at fourteen point nine two (14.92) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of one hundred nineteen point three six (119.36) square feet.

One (1) at fifteen (15) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of sixty (60) square feet.

One (1) at ten point nine two (10.92) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of forty-three point six eight (43.68) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at S Wabash Ave measure(s):

One (1) at six point six seven (6.67) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of twenty-six point six eight (26.68) square feet.

One (1) at six point seven five (6.75) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of twenty-seven (27) square feet.

Two (2) at fourteen point two five (14.25) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of one hundred fourteen (114) square feet.

One (1) at fourteen point one seven (14.17) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of fifty-six point six eight (56.68) square feet.

One (1) at fourteen point five (14.5) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of fifty-eight (58) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1123852 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from any after 07/06/2016.
