#### ORDINANCE

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language, as follows:

#### 4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(19.34)	On Kedzie Avenue, from 103rd Street to 105th Street
(19.35)	On Kedzie Avenue, from 105th Street to 107th Street
(19.36)	On Kedzie Avenue, from 107th Street to 109th Street
(19.37)	On Kedzie Avenue, from 109th Street to 111th Street
(19.38)	On Kedzie Avenue, from 111th Street to 115th Street
(19.39)	On the south side of 103rd Street, from Kedzie Avenue to Pulaski Road
(19.40)	On the east side of Pulaski Road, from 103rd Street to 107th Street

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
