**WHEREAS**, John F. Mulchrone retired as a Captain in the Chicago Police Department and was a longtime member of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange; and


**WHEREAS**, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of John F. Mulchrone serve as an example to all; and
