## LOADING ZONES

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

20	South Halsted Street; South Halsted Street (west side) from a point 90 feet south of West 65th Street to a point 50 feet south thereof; 15 Minutes Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, 6:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Saturday [Or2017-3]
27	1229 West Washington Boulevard; 1229 West Washington Boulevard (south side) from a point 203 feet east of North Elizabeth Street to a point 30 feet east thereof; 30 Minute Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, 8:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday -- (16-03429606) [O2016-3289]
32	North Honore Street; North Honore Street (east side) from a point 20 feet north of West Cortland Street to a point 20 feet north thereof; 15 Minute Standing Zone, Use Flashing Lights, 10:00am to 9:00pm, All Days -- (16-08087019) [O2016-7571]
