SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by revising Chapter 13 by deleting the language struck through as follows:

13-96-285 Space for Refuse Containers.

On a property with alloy refuse collection, suitable storage space for refuse containers shall be provided on the property adjacent to the alloy lot line, as required by Section 7-28-230, but in no case shall an area of less than 30 inches by 6 feet be provided. The storage space shall not be located in any required driveways, parking aisles, or parking spaces. The storage space shall not block or impede any fire exits or any pedestrian or vehicular access. The floor of the storage space shall be level and of concrete or equivalent noncombustible material.

13-124-335 Openings in guards.

Open guards shall have balusters or ornamental patterns such that a four-inch-diameter sphere cannot pass through any opening up to a height of 34 inches. From a height of 34 inches to 42 inches above the adjacent walking surfaces, a sphere eight inches in diameter shall not pass.

Guards shall not have an ornamental pattern that would provide a ladder effect.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance is effective upon passage and publication.
