BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS 3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-I in an area bound by

A line 75 feet East of and parallel to North Washtenaw Avenue, West Augusta Boulevard, a line 100 feet East of and parallel to North Washtenaw Avenue, the public alley next South and parallel to West Augusta Boulevard

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.
