### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD	TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:
27	800 North Elizabeth Street and West Chicago Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [O2017-4603]
27	West Grand Avenue and North Green Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2017-283]
27	West Hubbard Street and North Halsted Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2017-284]
33	West Eddy Street and North Albany Avenue; Two Way Stop Sign, Stopping East bound traffic on West Eddy Street at North Albany Avenue [Or2017-281]
33	West Eddy Street and North Troy Street; Two Way Stop Sign, Stopping West bound traffic on West Eddy Street at North Troy Street [Or2017-282]
35	North Kimball Avenue and West Waveland Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [O2016-8717]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
