ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit and RS3 Residential Single Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.15-G in an area bound by

The public alley next North of and parallel to West Victoria Street, a 124 foot long perpendicular line to West Victoria Street starting at a point 95.82 feet East of the East line of the public alley next East of and parallel to North Clark Street (as measured along the South line of the public alley next North of and parallel to West Victoria Street) and ending at a point of 85 feet East of the East line of the public alley next East of and parallel to North Clark Street (as measured along the North line of West Victoria Street); West Victoria Street; the public alley next and East of and parallel to North Clark Street.

to those of a C2-1 Neighborhood Commercial District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.
