#### ORDINANCE

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the area described in Section 2 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-023 (42.9), as follows:

#### 4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(42.9) On the south side of West Jackson Boulevard, between South Halsted Street and South Desplaines Street; and on the west side of South Desplaines Street, between West Jackson Boulevard and West Van Buren Street.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.
