ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS3 Residential Single-Unit Detached House District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 7-M in the area bounded by

to those of a RT3.5 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District.



In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about September 29, 2017, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from RS3 Residential Single-Unit Detached House District to RT3.5 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District on behalf of CMHDC-ALB LLC, an Illinois limited liability company, for the property located at 5858 West Diversey Avenue, Chicago, Illinois and described as follows:

The public alley next north of West Diversey Avenue, a line 32.30 feet east of the east line of North Marmora Avenue, West Diversey Avenue, North Marmora Avenue.
