ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B1-2 District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.13-J in the area bounded by

The alley next north of and parallel to West Lawrence Avenue; North Avers Avenue; West Lawrence Avenue; and a line 132 feet west of and parallel to North Avers Avenue,

to those of a B3-2 District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

PLAT OF SURVEY




