RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as Residential Permit Parking Zones, for the following locations:

WARD	AMEND RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES CONT'D:
13	6301-6359 South Kilbourn Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 09/06/2017, journal page 54954, which reads: 6301-6359 South Kilbourn Avenue (east side) including the wrap around on West 64th Street (north side) from West 64th Street east to the first alley; Residential Permit Parking Zone 2062, All Times, All Days, by Striking the above [Or2017-626]

4700-4712 South Seeley Avenue; Amend Ordinance which reads: 4700-4712 South Seeley Avenue and 4701-4711 South Seeley Avenue; Residential Permit Parking Zone 603, by Striking: 4700-4712 and 4701-4711 and Inserting: 4700-4712 and 4701-4711 to the alley in lieu thereof [O2017-8973]
