COLECTIVO COFFEE ROASTERS, INC
Acct. No. 412203 - 3

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago.

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to COLECTIVO COFFEE ROASTERS, INC, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use six (6) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5425 N. Clark St..

Said Awning(s) at N. Clark Street measure(s):

Two (2) at seven point seven five (7.75) feet in length, and four point five (4 5) feet in width for a total of sixty-nine point seven five (69.75) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at N. Clark Street measure(s):

One (1) at eleven point one six (11.16) feet in length, and four point five (4 5) feet in width for a total of fifty point two two (50.22) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at W. Rascher Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at nine point one six (9.16) feet in length, and four point five (4.5) feet in width for a total of forty-one point two two (41 22) square feet.

Said Awning(s) at W. Rascher Avenue measure(s):

Two (2) at seven point five (7.5) feet in length, and four point five (4.5) feet in width for a total of sixty-seven point five (67.5) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1130726 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

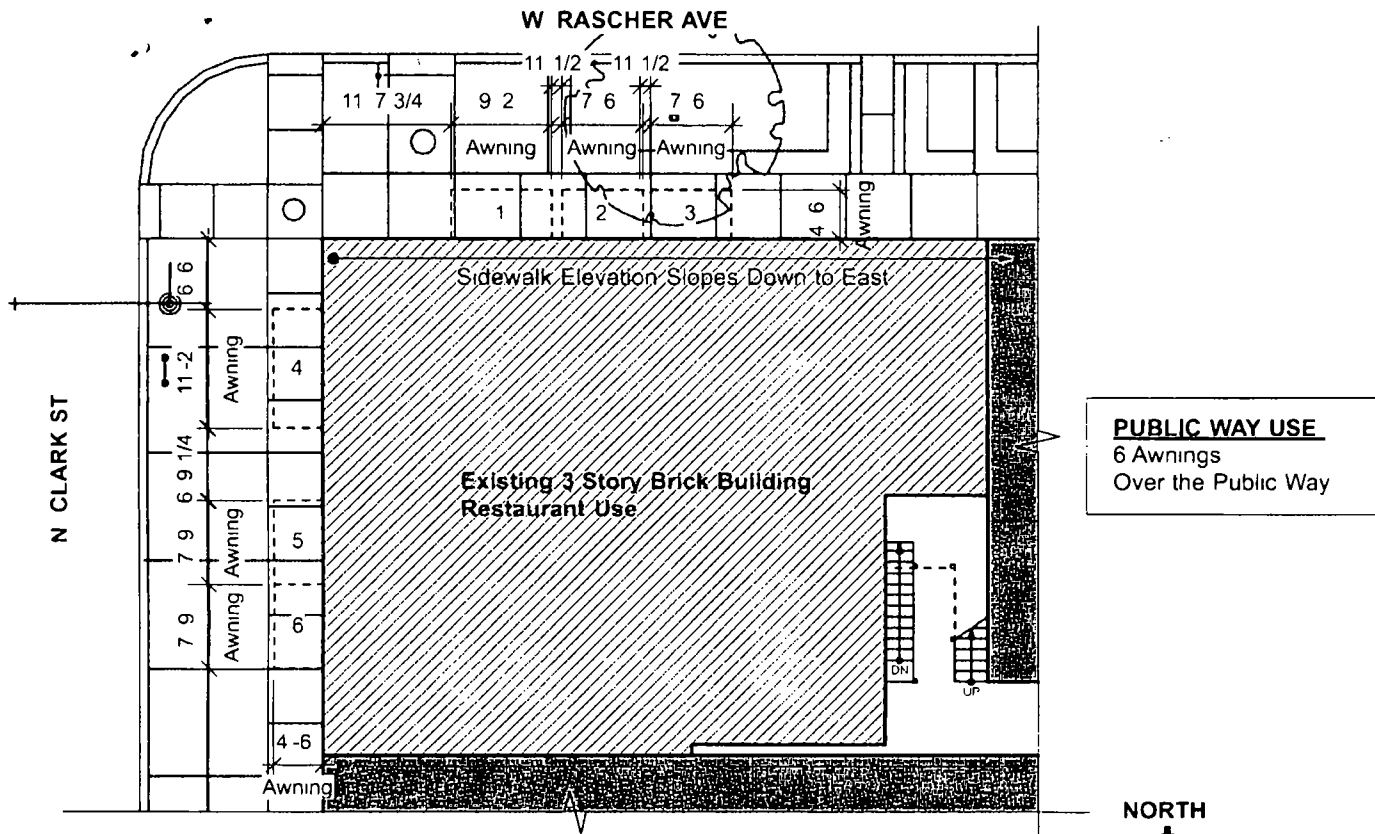
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

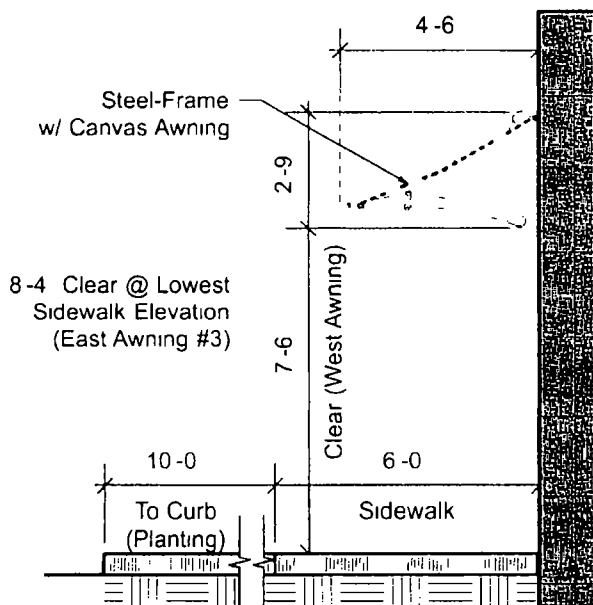

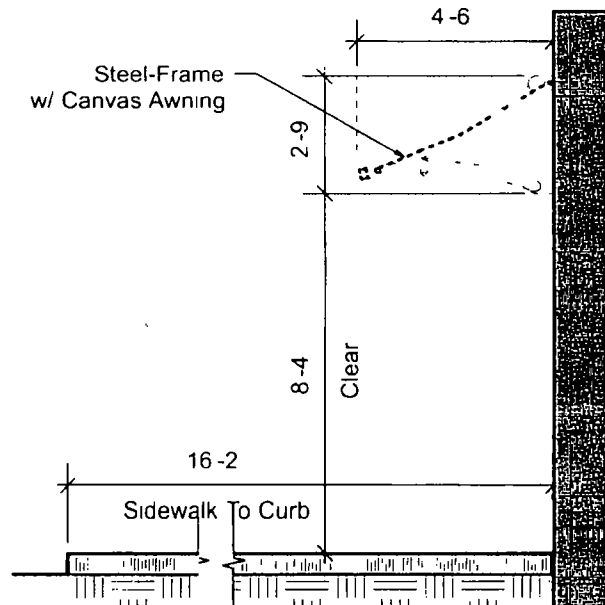
Harry Osterman 48th Ward
