ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of the RM5, Residential Multi-Unit District and the B3-3, Community Shopping District symbols as shown on Map No. 10-D in the area bounded by:






