ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. Section 9-64-110 of the Chicago Municipal Code is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

9-64-110 Parking prohibited - Roadways, sidewalks, bridges and similar locations.

It shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in any of the following places:

- (a) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
 - (1) Notwithstanding the above section, the fine shall be tripled for parking or standing a vehicle on the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street in the Central Business District, as defined by section 9-4-010.

(omitted portions are unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. Section 9-100-020 of the Chicago Municipal Code is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

- (a) The violation of any provision of the traffic code prohibiting or restricting vehicular standing or parking, or establishing a compliance, automated speed enforcement system, or automated traffic law enforcement system violation, shall be a civil offense punishable by fine, and no criminal penalty, or civil sanction other than that prescribed in the traffic code, shall be imposed.
- (b) The fines listed below shall be imposed for a violation of the following sections of the traffic code:

9-64-110(a) \$100.00 9-64-110(a)(1) \$300.00

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective upon passage and publication.
