### **TRAFFIC LANE – TOW ZONES**

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane – Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

## WARD TOW ZONES:

North Spaulding Avenue (east and west sides) from West Addison Street to the Cul De Sac south thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, 12:00am to 5:00am, Sunday to Monday [O2018-1035]
161 East Huron Street (south side) from North St. Clair Street to a point 140 feet west thereof; No Parking, No Stopping, No Standing -- (17-04742747) [O2017-4185]
West Addison Street (north side) from North Clark Street to a point 251 feet west thereof; No Stopping, No Standing; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days, Public Benefit -- (18-00530074) [O2018-71]
West Patterson Avenue (north and south sides) from North Clark Street to the first alley west thereof; No Stopping, No Standing, No Parking Tow Zone, Public Benefit -- (18-00529949) [O2018-73]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
