## **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning

Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of the RS3 Residential Single-Unit

(Detached House) District symbols as shown on Map No. 1-L

in the area bounded by:

A line 30 feet north of and parallel to West Ohio Street; North Lockwood Avenue; West Ohio Street; the public alley next west of and parallel to North Lockwood Avenue.

To those of an RT4, Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District

SECTION 2. This Ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.


