ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Zoning Ordinance, be amended by changing all of the PMD-6, Planned Manufacturing District No. 6 symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 24-B in the area bound by:

East 100th Street; a line 336.21 feet west of and parallel to the west line of the Calumet River; a line 50 feet south of an parallel to East 100th Street; a line 55.82 feet west of and parallel to the west line of the Calumet River; East 100th Street, Calumet River; the south line of Slip 2; a line 261.2 feet south of and parallel to the south line of Slip 2; the east line of the Private Railroad Street; West 102nd Street if extended where no street exists; the east line of the Private Railroad Street; a point 1172.4 feet northeast of the south line of Slip 2 along the Private Railroad Street; a radius of 70 41' 18" E to a point 933.4 feet west of a line 1068.4 feet parallel and east of the east line of the Private Railroad Street; a line 50 feet south of and parallel to East 100th Street; the east line of the Private Railroad Street,

to those of a Manufacturing Waterway Planned Development No. District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication.

PLANNED DEVELOPMENT STATEMENTS

- 2. The requirements, obligations and conditions contained within this Planned Development shall be binding upon the Applicant, its successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders and any ground lessors. All rights granted hereunder to the Applicant shall inure to the benefit of the Applicant's successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holder and any ground lessors. Furthermore, pursuant to the requirements of Section 17-8-0400 of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, the Property, at the time of application for amendments, modifications or changes (administrative, legislative or otherwise) to this Planned Development are made, shall be under single ownership or designated control. Single designated control is defined in Section 17-8-0400 of the Zoning Ordinance.
- 3. All applicable official reviews, approvals or permits are required to be obtained by the applicant or its successors, assignees or grantees. Any dedication or vacation of streets or alleys or grants of easements or any adjustment of the right-of-way shall require a separate submittal to the Department of Transportation on behalf of the Applicant or its successors, assign or grantees.

Any requests for grants of privilege, or any items encroaching on the public way, shall be in compliance with the Planned Development.

Ingress or egress shall be pursuant to the Planned Development and may be subject to the review and approval of the Departments of Planning and Development and Transportation. Closure of all or any public street or alley during demolition or construction shall be subject to the review and approval of the Department of Transportation.

All work proposed in the public way must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Department of Transportation Construction Standards for Work in the Public Way and in compliance with the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago. Prior to the issuance of any Part II approval, the submitted plans must be approved by the Department of Transportation.

4. This Plan of Development consists of 17 Statements: a Bulk Regulations Table; an Existing Zoning Map; an Existing Land-Use Map; a Planned Development Boundary and Property Line Map; Site Plan; and Landscape Plan, prepared by Reliable Asphalt Corporation and submitted herein. Full- sized copies of the Site Plan, Landscape Plan and Building Elevations are on file with the Department of Planning and Development. In any instance where a provision of this Planned Development conflicts with the Chicago Building Code, the Building Code shall control. This Planned Development conforms to the intent and purpose

of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, and all requirements thereto, and satisfies the established criteria for approval as a Planned Development. In case of a conflict between the terms of this Planned Development Ordinance and the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, this Planned Development shall control.

- 5. The following uses are permitted in the area delineated herein as a Planned Development:
 - Reprocessable Construction/Demolition Material Facility Recycling Operations
 - Class V Recycling Operations
 - Manufacturing, Production and Industrial Service (Artisan/Limited/General/ Intensive). Outdoor Storage and Raw Materials Storage and Work Activities (accessory and principal use). Warehousing and Freight Movement (all)
 - Construction Sales and Service (all)
 - Wholesale Sales, Retail Sales, General (sales of goods produced or stored on-site
 - Signs, Advertising (Billboards), Wireless Communication Facilities (all)
 - Accessory Uses (as defined in § 17-17-0206 of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance).
- 6. On-Premise signs and temporary signs, such as construction and marketing signs, shall be permitted within the Planned Development, subject to the review and approval of the Department of Planning and Development. Off-Premise signs are subjected to the review and approval of the Department of Planning and Development.
- 7. For purposes of height measurement, the definitions in the Chicago Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The height of any building shall also be subject to height limitations, if any, established by the Federal Aviation Administration.
- 8. The maximum permitted floor area ratio (FAR) for the Property shall be in accordance with the attached Bulk Regulations and Data Table. For the purpose of FAR calculations and measurements, the definitions in the Zoning Ordinance shall apply. The permitted FAR identified in the Bulk Regulations and Data Table has been determined using a net site area of 2,489,164 square feet and a base FAR of 1.0.
- 9. Upon review and determination, and pursuant to Section 17-13-0610 of the Zoning Ordinance, Part II Review shall be assessed a fee by the Department of Planning and Development. The fee, as determined by staff at the time of its submission, is final and binding on the Applicant and must be paid to the Department of Revenue prior to the issuance of any Part II approval.
- 10. The Site and Landscape Plans shall be in substantial conformance with the Landscape Ordinance and any other corresponding regulations and guidelines, including Section 17-13-0800 of the Zoning Ordinance. Final landscape plan review and approval will be by the Department of Planning and Development. Any interim reviews associated with site plan review or Part TI Reviews, are conditional until final Part II approval.
- 11. The Applicant may exceed the limits on the height of stockpiles as set forth in the Rules and Regulations for the Maintenance of Stockpiles promulgated by the Commissioners of the Department of Streets and Sanitation, and the Department of Fleet and Facility Management,

- of the Municipal Code, or any other provision of the Municipal Code, but in no case shall the vertical distance from grade to the highest point of the stockpile be greater than 50 feet.
- 12. The terms and conditions of development under this Planned Development ordinance may be modified administratively, pursuant to Section 17-13-0611-A of the Zoning Ordinance, by the Zoning Administrator upon the application for such a modification by the Applicant, its successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders and any ground lessors.
- 13. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct and maintain the project in a manner which promotes, enables and maximizes universal access throughout the Property. Plans for all buildings and improvements on the Propelty shall be reviewed and approved by the Mayor's Office for People with Disabilities to ensure compliance with all applicable laws and regulations related to access for persons with disabilities and to promote the highest standard of accessibility.
- 14. The Applicant acknowledges that it is in the public interest to design, construct, renovate and maintain all buildings in a manner that provides healthier indoor environments, reduces operating costs and conserves energy and natural resources. The Applicant shall obtain the number of points necessary to meet the requirements of the Chicago Sustainable Development Policy, in effect at the time the Part II review process is initiated for each improvement that is subject to the aforementioned Policy and must provide documentation verifying compliance.
- 15. The Applicant acknowledges the city's ongoing and evolving initiatives to enhance awareness of, and support and encourage participation by, Minority and Women's Business Enterprise certified contractors and local city residents. To assist the city in promoting such MBE, WBE and local city resident involvement, the Applicant may provide the Department of Planning and Development with any preliminary outreach plans designed to elicit MBE, WBE and local city resident participation, such submission may include copies of certified letters, and receipts of such, sent to MBE/WBE contractor associations and the ward office of the alderman in which this project is proposed to be located. In conjunction with the Applicant's submission for Part II permit reviews, the Applicant will provide DPD (and upon request, the full Plan Commission) with all responses to any preliminary outreach plans and certified letters, updates on any associated communications or meetings and anticipated percentages of MBE, WBE and local city resident participation. Prior to issuance of their Certificate of Occupancy, the Applicant will provide DPD with actual level of MBE and WBE certified contractor and local city resident participation. All such details will be provided in a form acceptable to the Zoning Administrator or Commissioner of the Department of Planning and Development.
- 16. Changes and expansions in Planned Development shall be subject to Site Plan Review pursuant to this section. Prior to the Part II Approval (Section 17-13-0610 of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance) of changes and expansions, the Applicant shall submit a site plan, landscape plan and building elevations for review and approval by DPD. Review and approval by DPD is intended to assure that specific development components substantially

The Site Plan Approval Submittal (Section 17-13-0800) need only include that portion of the Property for which approval is being sought by the Applicant. The site plan provided shall include all dimensioned and planned street Rights-of-Way.

No Part II Approval for changes and expansions shall be granted until Site Plan Approval has been granted. Following approval by DPD, the approved Site Plan Approval Submittals, supporting data and materials shall be made part of the main file and shall be deemed to be an integral part of the PD.

After approval of the Site Plan, changes or modifications may be made pursuant to the provisions of Statement 12. In the event of any inconsistency between approved plans and the terms of the PD, the terms of the PD shall govern. Any Site Plan Approval Submittals shall, at a minimum, provide the following information:

- fully-dimensioned site plan (including a footprint of the proposed improvements);
- fully-dimensioned building elevations;
- fully-dimensioned landscape plan(s); and,
- statistical information applicable to the building expansion, including floor area, the applicable floor area ratio, uses to be established, building heights and setbacks.

Site Plan Approval Submittals shall include all other information deemed necessary by either the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation or Fire Department to illustrate substantial conformance to the PD.

17. This Planned Development shall be governed by Section 17-13-0612. Should this Planned Development ordinance lapse, the Commissioner of the Department of Planning and Development shall initiate a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone the property to the preexisting Planned Manufacturing District No. 6.

Project Narrative

In order to foster the City's industrial base, enhance its diversified economy, and to more efficiently support the City's investment in critical infrastructure repair and replacement, Reliable Asphalt Corporation has applied for a special use permit to establish a Class V recycling operation, reprocessible construction and demolition material recycling operation, redi-mix operation, and material storage operation in Planned Manufacturing District 6 within property located at 3203 East 100th Street, Chicago, Illinois.

Materials to be processed at this facility will be used primarily in repaving and trench backfill projects for the City of Chicago. Operations will include sorting and crushing broken concrete and asphalt; sorting, crushing, and grinding broken asphalt and asphalt shingles; and storing and transferring clean soil. A complete description of the types of materials that may be processed onsite is provided herewith as part of a letter to Patricia Scudiero from Jacob Mrugacz dated February 6, 2018. Warehousing and business-to-business sales of raw materials also will be conducted onsite.

Private contractors and City of Chicago construction crews will have a convenient south side location where waste can be recycled and raw materials can be purchased. Site operations will reduce truck staging and traffic on local streets, thereby reducing wear and tear on local roadways.

At this time, soil, broken concrete, and broken asphalt pavement and asphalt shingles generated from construction — including the City of Chicago's extensive water and sewer main replacement program — is often hauled long distances. The waste materials are transported from construction sites to transfer stations then to final disposal facilities. Some contractors working on projects in the City must leave the City to deliver materials for recycling then must make additional stops to pick up raw materials. At this time, the nearest similar facilities are operating at 2100 South Kilbourne Avenue, 21.1 miles from the subject site, and 3741 South Pulaski Road, 17.3 miles from the subject site.

The proposed operation will offer an alternative location where construction crews can both drop off construction and demolition waste and also pick up raw materials. The facility will improve efficiencies in all south side construction jobs because trucks will be able to drop off and load up at the same site. In addition, raw and processed materials will be transported via barge using the adjacent channel and Calumet River.

Applicant enjoys a positive reputation for engaging with the local community to produce favorable outcomes and long-term positive impacts. It has been responsibly serving the community from its location at 3741 South Pulaski Road for over 30 years. That facility holds a Class V license and conducts operations that are similar to those proposed for the subject property. Applicant also operates a similar facility at 4613 West Grand Avenue; that facility holds environmental permits for both Class V and reprocessible construction and demolition material recycling operations.

The subject site is in an industrial area, adjacent to railroad tracks and the Calumet River, with very few residential neighbors (nearest home is more than 250 feet from the operation). Likewise, no schools, childcare facilities, nursing homes, hospitals or parks are near the proposed operation. The proposed use is comparable to the current use and consistent with the goals and objectives of PMD 6.

Please be informed that on or about May 16, 2018, Reliable Asphalt Corporation ("Reliable"), will file an application with the City of Chicago for a change in zoning (also known as Zoning Map Amendment) for the Property.
