ORDINANCE
SINAI HEALTH SYSTEM
Acct. No. 379117 - 1
Permit No. 1133418

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SINAI HEALTH SYSTEM, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Conduit(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2750 W. 15th St..

Said Conduit(s) at S. Washtennaw Avenue/West 15th Street/West 15th Place and Public Alleys measure(s):
One (1) at five hundred nineteen (519) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of five hundred nineteen (519) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1133418 herein granted the sum of three thousand one hundred fourteen (\$3,114.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 05/08/2018.

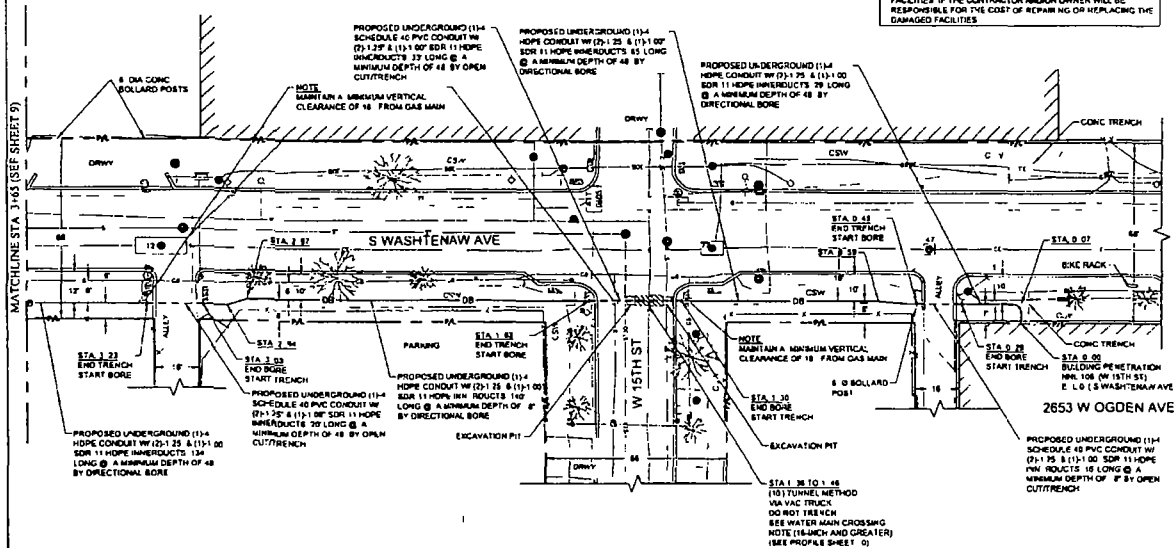

CONSTRUCTION NOTE
FOR FIBER PULL ASSISTANCE, LEAVE
STRATEGIC PULL ACCESS POINTS
EXPOSED AND PLATED WITH HOT
UNDER CONSTRUCTION UNTIL THE
FIBER PULL IS COMPLETED. ONCE THE
PULL IS COMPLETED, INSTALL SPLIT
DUCT ON EXPOSED ROUTE AND ENCASE
IN CONCRETE. ALL RESTORATION
SHOULD BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH CDDT
RESTORATION GUIDELINES (SEE SHEET
FOR FURTHER DETAIL.)

WATER CROSSING NOTES (11" AND GREATER)
HAND EXCAVATION IS REQUIRED TO FIELD VERIFY THE
HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATION OF THE 30-INCH WATER
MAIN PRIOR TO CROSSING. A TRENCHLESS METHOD OF
INSTALLATION IS USED. A MINIMUM 4' FOOT OF UNDISTURBED
SOIL IS TO REMAIN ON EITHER SIDE OF THE EXISTING WATER
MAIN. IF THE PROPOSED FACILITY WILL BE INSTALLED VIA
OPEN CUT METHOD, THE EXCAVATION MUST BE PROPERLY
SHORED TO MAINTAIN A MINIMUM 3' FOOT TRENCH WIDTH. THE
TRENCH SHALL BE BACKFILLED TO THE SURFACE OF THE
WATER MAIN WITH COLSAP BACKFILL (NON FLY ASH) AND CA-18
FROM SPRINKLER OF THE WATER MAIN TO GRADE. USE OF
POLYETHYLENE WRAP AS A BOND BREAKER BETWEEN THE
WATER MAIN AND THE CLSM BACKFILL IS REQUIRED. FAILURE TO
COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN
ADDITIONAL EXPENSES TO THE PROPOSED PROJECT TO VERIFY
THAT ALL WORK CONFORMS TO DWR'S STANDARDS. EXTREME
CAUTION MUST BE TAKEN TO AVOID DAMAGE TO ANY WATER
FACILITIES IF THE CONTRACTOR AND/OR OWNER WILL BE
RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF REPAIRING OR REPLACING THE
DAMAGED FACILITIES.
