


**WHEREAS**, All Chicagoans owe Major General Marks a great deal and would like to honor him in every way possible; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to Major General James "Spider" Marks for their service to the United States of America.








