ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1: Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is amended by changing all the B1-5 Neighborhood Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 6-F in the area bounded by:

West 28th Street; the public alley next east of and parallel to South Halsted Street; a line 85 feet south of and parallel to West 28th Street; South Halsted Street

to those of a B1-3 Neighborhood Shopping District, which is hereby established in the area described.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and due publication.

The proposed zoning change is from B1-5 to a B1-3.

The proposed project is a 30-unit, 4-story residential building with approximately 1,225 square feet of commercial space, 20 auto parking spaces and 30 bicycle parking spaces.
