#### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-L in the area bounded by

West Potomac Avenue; a line 287.08 feet east of and parallel to North Lockwood Avenue; the public alley next south of and parallel to West Potomac Avenue; a line 257.08 feet east of and parallel to North Lockwood Avenue

to those of RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.



In accordance with the Amendment to the Zoning Code enacted by the City Council, Section 17-13-0107-A of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, please be advised that on or about October 24, 2018, the undersigned, will file an application for a change in zoning for the property located at 5233 W Potomac Avenue from a RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District to a RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District.

The owner of the property and the applicant of the Zoning Amendment Application is Jeremy Mann and Andrew Follett, located at 404 Lake Street, Suite 201, Oak Park, Illinois 60302.

The applicant seeks a zoning amendment from a RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District to a RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District to allow for a third dwelling unit on the ground floor of a 2 story, 2 dwelling unit building.
