Grant(s) of privilege in public way for Eight O Five - caissons

ORDINANCE EIGHT O FIVE Acct. No. 432202 - 1 Permit No. 1136283

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to EIGHT O FIVE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, fifteen (15) Caisson(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 805 N. La Salle Dr..

Said Caisson(s) at W. Chicago Avenue measure(s):

Six (6) at twelve point five (12 5) feet in length, and two point six six (2.66) feet in width for a total of one hundred ninety-nine point five (199.5) square feet.

Said Caisson(s) at N. La Salle Street measure(s):

Two (2) at twelve point five (12.5) feet in length, and two point six six (2.66) feet in width for a total of sixty-six point five (66.5) square feet.

Two (2) at nineteen point six seven (19.67) feet in length, and one point seven five (1.75) foot in width for a total of sixty-eight point eight five (68.85) square feet.

Two (2) at eighteen point five (18.5) feet in length, and one point seven five (1.75) foot in width for a total of sixty-four point seven five (64.75) square feet.

Two (2) at eighteen point nine two (18.92) feet in length, and one point seven five (1.75) foot in width for a total of sixty-six point two two (66.22) square feet.

One (1) at nine point seven five (9.75) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of four point eight eight (4.88) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1136283 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400 00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way


