#### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance; is hereby amended by changing all of the B3-2 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 4-H in the area bounded by

West 21<sup>st</sup> Street; a line 200.00 feet west of and parallel to South Paulina Street; the public alley next south of and parallel to West 21<sup>st</sup> Street; a line 225.00 feet west of and parallel to South Paulina Street

to those of RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.



In accordance with the Amendment to the Zoning Code enacted by the City Council, Section 17-13-0107-A of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, please be advised that on or about December 5, 2018, the undersigned, will file an application for a change in zoning for the property located at 1721 W 21st Street from a B3-2 Community Shopping District to a RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

The owner of the property and the applicant of the Zoning Amendment Application is Midway Assets LLC, located at 12929 Blue Grass Drive, Lemont, Illinois 60439.

The applicant seeks a zoning amendment from a B3-2 Community Shopping District to a RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District to renovate an existing 2 dwelling unit building, which has no parking spaces.
