A line 43 feet south of and parallel with West Shakespeare Avenue;

The alley next west of and parallel with North Springfield Avenue;

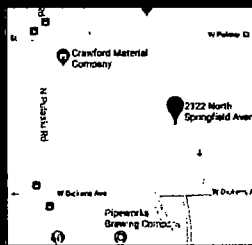
to those of a RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District, which is hereby established in the area described.

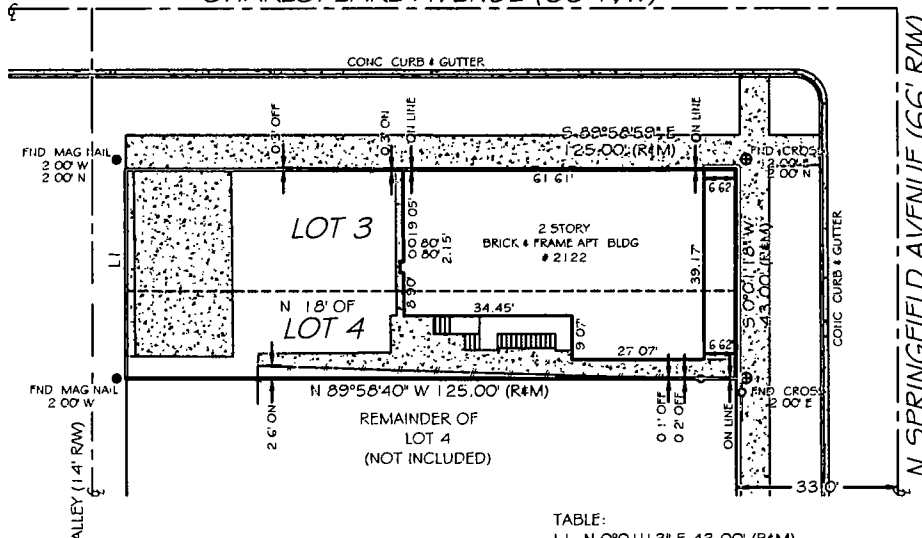

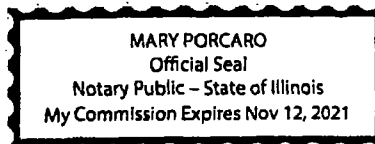


