#### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1: That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by changing all RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 10-D in the area bounded by

a line 260.00 feet north of and parallel to East 47<sup>th</sup> Street; South Drexel Boulevard, East 47<sup>th</sup> Street; the alley next west of and parallel to South Drexel Boulevard;

to those of the B1-1 Neighborhood Shopping District and a corresponding use district is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

#### **Project Narrative and Plans**

Chicago, IL (4644-4658 S. Drexel) LLC, is the applicant, for the property located at 4644-4658 S. Drexel Blvd., Chicago, IL 60653. They seek a zoning map amendment to change the zoning district from RM-5 Zoning District to B1-1. The applicant intends to use the subject property as a physical fitness center, renovating the existing 12,000 square foot building with a building height of approximately 14 feet. The current zoning district for this property does not allow the proposed use. Additionally, the current zoning does not impose a height limitation, but the proposed zoning district does have a height limitation.

A. Floor Area Ratio: 0.23.

B. Density: 20.826 minimum lot area per dwelling unit; N/A for this site.

C. Off-street Parking: 83 parking spaces in the attached lot.

D. Setbacks: Front: 56 feet



View from East looking West from Drexel Blvd.


