**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the area described in Section 2 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (42.42), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of April 18, 2018 at page 76370, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (42.42) On the south side of Huron Street, from Franklin Street to Wells Street; and on the west side of Wells Street, from Huron Street to Erie Street.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
