# <u>ORDINANCE</u>

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the M1-2 Limited Manufacturing/Business Park

District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.4-F in the area bounded by

a line 82 feet north of and parallel to West Cermak Road; South Emerald Avenue; a line 34 feet north of and parallel West Cermak Road; and South Halsted Street,

to those of a B3-3 Community Shopping District is hereby established in the areà above described.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
