Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, a Paved CrossWalk on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5530 S. Ellis Ave.. Existing paved crosswalk measure twenty-nine (29) feet in length and ten (10) feet in width for a total of two hundred ninety (290) square feet and located at South Ellis Avenue in front of the new Gerald Ratner Athletics Center. Existing crosswalk indicate to pedestrians where to cross the street to enter the building and indicate to vehicles that pedestrians will be crossing in this special paved area.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1140709 herein granted the sum of six hundred three (\$603.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

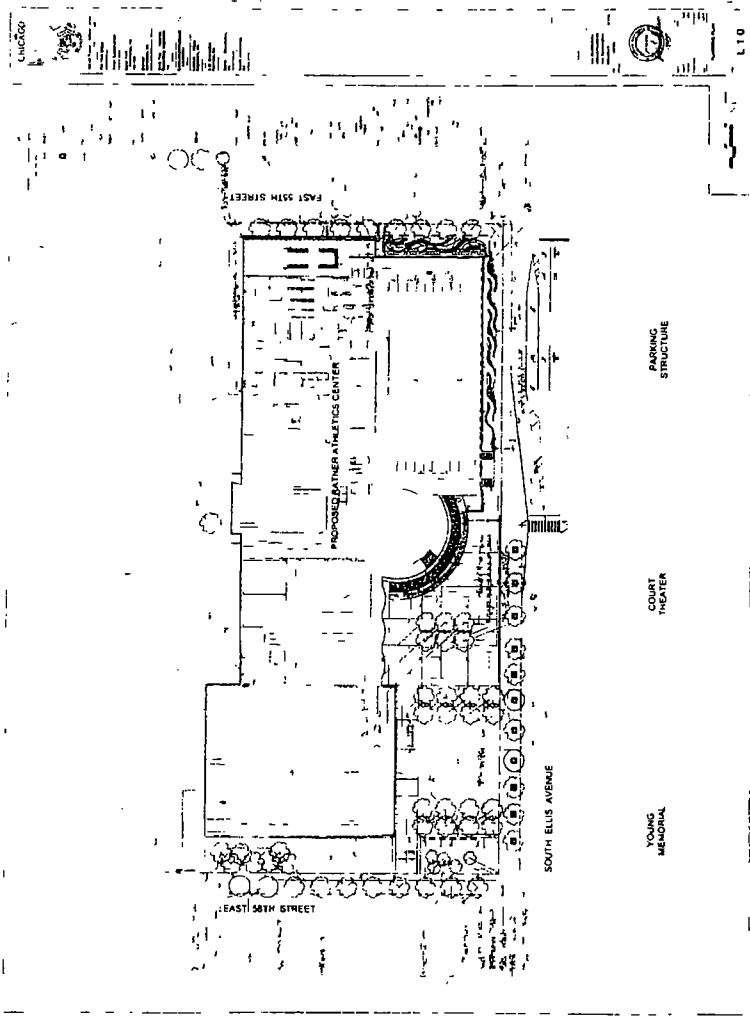
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
