ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS3 Single-Unit Detached House District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 14-G in the area bounded by:

A line 238 feet north of and parallel to the north line of West 61st Street, the public alley next east of South Green Street, a line 207.84 feet north of and parallel to the north line of 61st Street, South Green Street

to those of a RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.



In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about July 12, 2019, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from RS3 Single-Unit Detached House District to RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District on behalf of Hope Manor Village Housing Limited Partnership, an Illinois limited partnership, for the property located 6035-6039 South Green Street, Chicago, Illinois and described as follows:

A line 238 feet north of and parallel to the north line of West 61st Street, the public alley next east of South Green Street, a line 207.84 feet north of and parallel to the north line of 61st Street, South Green Street,

The purpose of the zoning amendment is to permit the applicant to construct a three unit, three story building. There will be three off-street parking spaces. The maximum building height of the building will not exceed 38 feet.
