ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Chapter 4-17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago authorizes the establishment of Restricted Residential Zones pursuant to an opt-out process, which requires a petition to trigger an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The requisite procedural requirements have been met; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Sections 4-17-020 and 04-17-040 of the Municipal Code of Chicago ("Code"), the 35th Precinct of the 13th Ward, as described herein, is hereby designated as a Restricted Residential Zone within the meaning of Chapter 4-17 of the Code. All new or additional shared housing units and vacation rentals shall be prohibited with the boundaries of such 35th Precinct, with such boundaries beginning at the intersection of South Kilbourn Avenue and West 63rd Street, thence east on West 63rd Street to South Kenneth Avenue, thence south on South Kenneth Avenue to the alley north of West 64th Street, thence east on the alley north of West 64th Street to South Kedvale Avenue to West 65th Street, thence west on 65th Street to South Tripp Avenue, thence north on South Tripp Avenue, thence north on South Tripp Avenue to West 64th Street to South Kilbourn Avenue to the place of the beginning.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage and publication, and shall remain in effect for four years following its effective date.
