ORDINANCE HANS KIEF Acct. No. 68650 - 1 Permit No. 1142296

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to HANS KIEF, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Vault(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 642 N. Clark St.

Said Vault(s) at N. Clark Street measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-one (21) feet in length, and thirteen (13) feet in width for a total of two hundred seventy-three (273) square feet. Existing vault area is used for utilities and storage.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1142296 herein granted the sum of seven hundred eighty-six (\$786.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.


