ORDINANCE MUSIC AND DANCE THEATER CHICAGO Acct. No. 250547 - 1 Permit No. 1142730

## Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to MUSIC AND DANCE THEATER CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Vault(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 205 E. Randolph St..

Said Vault(s) at Lower E. Randolph Street measure(s):

One (1) at eighty-eight (88) feet in length, and ten point five four (10.54) feet in width for a total of nine hundred twenty-seven point five two (927.52) square feet. Said vaulted area shall be used as an extension of an existing theater lobby.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1142730 herein granted the sum of five thousand three hundred forty-three (\$5,343.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicagó harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 11/05/2019.
